



THE ODD FELLOWS HALL


St. Luke and Odd Fellows Hall is a museum of African American Culture and the former social gathering spot for the African American community. In 2009 the town restored the hall and officially reopened its doors. The exhibit on display is titled From Civil War to Civil Rights, chronicling the lives of African Americans throughout the years, some of whom lived in Blacksburg's historic New Town!

Blacksburg was developed because it was situated along one of the East-West routes through the Valley of Virginia. Originating from the "Sixteen Squares" which were the first organized, developed land that made up the town, Blacksburg has grown far beyond its original

ALEXANDER BLACK HOUSE




Built in 1897 by Alexander Black, this house was a funeral home until 2002, when it was bought by the town of Blacksburg.

In order to make room for a new parking garage, the house was then picked up and moved across the street in one piece!

The house is now a museum promoting local history, art, and culture.

A Victrola was a specific brand of record player, made between 1901 and 1929.





When Alexander Black had his store, people would have bought these to listen to music. Can you name some things you use to listen to music now?

ALEXANDER BLACK

Alexander Black was a businessman in the late 1800s. On the first floor of his store on Main Street he sold hardware, Christmas toys, electrical goods and specialties. The second floor was filled with furniture, radios, Victrolas, and other articles for the home.
